

School Uniform Policy

School uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of a school. It helps to instill pride in the school, supports positive behaviour and discipline, encourages identity and support for the school and protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way. Above all, it helps to support effective teaching and learning.

Our uniform policy gives our children the opportunity to be as smart and well turned out as any other school in the local area. We therefore request the support of all parents in our efforts to uphold the standards of our school uniform.

Sweatshirt/cardigan/hoodie	Red with school logo.
Skirt/Dress/Trousers	Plain grey/navy/black – school style. Summer gingham school dress.
T Shirts	Red polo T shirt with school logo
Tights	Plain grey, navy, black, red
Outdoor Shoes/boots	Plain, flat, black/grey/navy lace up/strap/velcro styles only. No trainers. Sandals may be worn appropriate to weather conditions without obvious embellishments or being glittery– more flexibility with colour. No flip flops.
Indoor Shoes/Slippers	Plimsoles or slippers with a hard sole – suitable for waering outside in the evnt of a fire alarm.
Hair accessories	Long hair must be tied off the shoulder to prevent those hair visitors! Plain hair bands/bobbles/scrunchies. Embellishments or adornments are not allowed.

Book Bags/PE Bags are available to purchase in red with school logo.

Jewellery and Personal Adornment

Jewellery is not allowed. If ears have been pierced one small pair of studs is allowed. All watches must be removed for PE. Temporary tattoo stickers are not permitted. No make up should be worn.

Outdoor/Indoor Footwear

We encourage out pupils to use the outdoor area and adventure playground during playtimes and lessons times. This often results in footwear becoming muddy. To prevent mud being taken through the school, we ask all pupils to bring plimsoles or slippers with hard soles to change into when coming inside. The indoor footwear must have a sufficient sole so that in the case of a fire alarm, they are suitable for wearing outside for a short period of time.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Will the school supply only the compulsory school purchased items?

Yes. Only the items that require a logo will be available from the school. All other items have been chosen to be readily available from a range of High Street shops and chain stores.

Does the school make a profit on the sale of school uniform?

The school will not make a profit on the sale of uniform.

Where can I find a copy of the school uniform policy?

Paper copies are available from the school office and on the school website.

How do I order school uniform?

Parents with children entering Reception will be able to pre order uniform ready for the September start. Information about this will be given at the Induction Days and order forms can be found in the school office. Orders with payment should then be given to the office.

What does 'plain' mean in the policy?

The definition of plain in the policy is "no fashion embellishments, no contrasting colours, stripes or markings, no advertisements or brand logos". This helps to ensure that we minimise competition between the children in terms of the clothes that they wear.
